This will be a one-year competitive advanced post FCPS fellowship in Head and Neck Surgery with particular emphasis on Head and Neck Oncology. The fellowship will be based in two major private teaching hospitals in Peshawar i.e. Northwest General hospital (NWGH) and Rehman Medical Institute (RMI).

BACKGROUND

These two hospitals are well-established tertiary care institutes and treat population from Pakistan and in addition, Afghanistan, which includes Head and Neck pathologies. Amongst the two hospitals there is wide spread presentation of Head and Neck diseases which include benign and malignant pathologies.

The principle departments involved in this fellowship will be the ENT Department at NWGH and Maxillofacial Department at RMI.

This primary team in addition will, be supported by the Radiology, Oncology, Nuclear Medicine and Pathology departments across these sites.

This post will also see the establishment of a regional fortnightly Head and Neck MDT for patients presenting with diseases to this anatomical region across these two sites (currently there is an active monthly MDT).

EXPECTED RESPONSIBILITIES

The Fellowship will offer a well-balanced exposure to all aspects of head and neck cancer surgery and benign tumour surgery. The candidate will be expected to be actively involved in the academic activity of the department and research will be encouraged. The fellow will be required to complete an audit and a research project during their fellowship.

There will also be an important service provision component with both operating lists and outpatient clinics, as well as on call commitments, which will be shared with the middle grade staff.

The fellow will also be expected to work as a member and coordinate the Head and Neck Cancer multidisciplinary team

meetings.

The successful post holder will receive Consultant-led education and supervision and will be supported in their professional development as a Head and Neck surgeon.

They will also be able to gain experience in other aspects of their respective fields as both main surgical supervisors treat a variety of conditions. This includes endoscopic ear and nasal surgeries along with common dental and maxillofacial pathologies.

There will be tri monthly assessment meeting with the supervisor(s) to ensure the fellow's targets for this fellowship are being achieved and any deficiencies are addressed. Work based assessment and logbook will be used to ensure training requirements are being met.
